## Dear Families,

Your child recently took the Pearson Review of Progress & Learning (PRoPL), which is a short assessment designed to provide information about what they have learned so far this school year. PRoPL is administered in the fall, winter, and spring in either reading or math or in both subjects. Students take PRoPL assessments online and teachers receive the results immediately.

PRoPL provides the number of test questions students answered correctly (raw score), scale score, and performance levels. Scale scores are based on raw scores, which enable comparisons of student performance across tests within a subject area and grade level. There are three performance levels, which are a way to interpret your student's performance on the scale score.

The PRoPL reports contain information that can support conversations with your child's teacher about their learning. This provides an opportunity for you to ask questions regarding what the scores mean, how you can help at home, and what types of strategies will be implemented at school to support your child.

PRoPL is just one assessment teachers use throughout the year, in addition to monitoring grades and other information, to understand how to best address your child's needs. If you have any questions, please reach out to your child's teacher. We appreciate your support.
